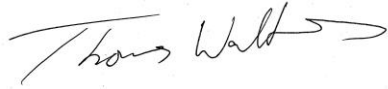
*Note: Section 3, - Maximum possible scores were adjusted to be consistent with all applications as different types of programs had a different total amount of points. This was to ensure applications were comparable. Section 2 resulted in the greatest variation in scores and ultimately adjustments in Section 3 had little to no effect on final scores.
